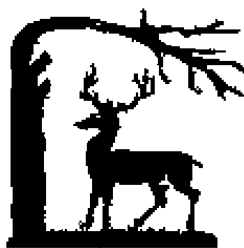

### Team Managers Report – Cleveland October 2013

Our first home match of the 2013 /2014 season saw us home to Cleveland, the Ladies B losing 4 – 2, with Carole Holroyd getting us off with a win 3 – 0, and a Lady of the Match performance with an average of 16.24, the next two games went to Cleveland, Priscilla Cummings 3 – 0 (13.59) and Amy Smith 3 – 0 (15.60), Jackie Walford won 3 – 0 (15.34), but loses for newly recalled Louise Walford 3 – 0 (13.74) and Chris Ruffell 3 – 2 (12.62).

The Men's B, started off with a win for Steve Shadwell 3 – 1 (24.08) but we lost the next two, John Gray 3 – 0 (20.96) and Roy Barton 3 – 0 (21.16), Lee Drinkwater won 3 – 2 (22.67) but Cleveland won the next three, Richard Stride 3 – 2 (22.71), Luke Woodland 3 – 1 (22.73) and Dan Woodcraft 3 – 1 (20.79) losing. With the score line at 5 – 2 in favour of Cleveland, we won the next three, Terry Stubbs producing a Man of the Match performance 3 – 1 (25.84), Steve Greene 3 – 1 (24.47) and Paul Croucher 3 – 2 (23.06) taking out a 101 finish in the deciding leg. Andy McNeil-Aitken lost 3 – 2 ( 22.20) leaving the pressure of Bill Foot to either draw or lose the match, but Bill won 3 – 1 (21.82) giving the Men's B draw and the overnight score line of 10 – 8 in favour of Cleveland.

The Ladies A also produced a draw, with us going 2 – 0 up, Ally Judge 3 -1 ( 18.02) and Debbie Shadwell 3 – 2 (17.73), Jo Rolls was unlucky losing 3 – 2 (18.66), Debbie Connors won with a Lady of the Match result of 3 – 0 (18.33), but both Hayley Croucher lost 3 – 0 (15.64) and Kate Denton 3 – 0 (16.05) lost.

At the start of the Men's A Cleveland were 13 – 11 in the lead. John Jamison lost 4 – 0 (20.92), Paul Roe was up next with a brilliant performance winning 4 – 0 ( 29.91), the next two went to Cleveland Gary Jones 4 – 2 ( 23.36) and John Hall 4 – 3 (23.14), Paul Hogan won 4 – 1 (28.77), but again Cleveland took the next two, Simon Purvey 4 – 3 (23.20) and Luke Humphries 4 – 3 (20.39), with the score line at 18 – 13, we needed the remaining games to secure the draw, Steve Rose won 4 – 1 (27.64), Paul Snowsill played brilliantly with a Man of the Match win 4 – 0 with an average of 31.81, then Joe Lacey followed with another win 4 – 3 (26.80), Terry Stubbs was next up after seeing him win on the Saturday, he stepped up to the A side but unfortunately could not secure the win, but played well in his 1<sup>st</sup> A team debut 4 – 2 (24.98), Kevin Morley gave us the last game winning 4 – 3 (24.67), giving the Men'A final result of a draw and the overall weekend result of 17 – 19 to Cleveland

Our next match will see us away to Norfolk, 02/03 November 2013, let's play like we can and support each other and I feel sure that we will secure a win.
